Introduction:

1. Why do you participate in the church?

- A. Far too often the motivation we have for participation in church is a spirit of consumerism.
- B. Consider: What is the purpose of the church anyway?
- C. We have already identified that there are two primary Scriptures that describe the purpose of the church.
Matthew 28:18-20 (NIV), **Mark 12:29-31** (NIV)

Body:

I. The *Great Commission* is all about evangelism. **Matthew 28:19** (NIV)

- A. Making disciples is evangelism.
- B. Evangelism is, in essence, Making Him Known.
2 Tim. 4:1-5 (NIV)

II. The way we evangelize.

- A. Communicate Good News
2 Tim. 4:5 (NIV)
- B. Baptize them.
1 Peter 3:21 (ESV)

III. The ways we evangelize.

- A. Corporately
- B. We also evangelize personally.

Conclusion:

- A. Christian this is our purpose: To Know Him and to Make Him Known.
- B. If you are not a Christian, would you like to personally come to know the God who created you, loves you and sent His Son to die for you that you might have your sins forgiven and live with Him forever?
