Title: Our Compassionate King  
Text: John 8:1-11

(Sanctity of Human Life Sunday)

Introduction:

[Genesis 3:6-8 \(NLT\)](#)

- A. When our human nature overthrows the nature of God in us we experience the emotional pain of shame.
- B. Shame is a very real part of the pain that post-abortion parents live with. [John 8:1-11](#)

Body:

- I. A sinner bears the burden of shame.
  - A. There she stood, an adulteress, caught in the act.
  - B. Sinners are hurting people. [Romans 6:21 \(NIV\)](#)
  - C. The suffering is there because there because the conception and life of a baby is a one-flesh experience that procreates the image of God.
- II. Sinners also bear the burden of condemnation.
  - A. It is universal. [James 2:10-11](#)
  - B. We should never heap contempt upon condemnation.
  - C. Look at how Jesus responded to the contempt of the Pharisees. [John 8:6-8 \(NIV\)](#), [Jeremiah 17:13](#)
  - D. Church we need to examine our hearts and hear the words of Jesus. [Romans 14:13](#)
- III. A sinner's burden is lifted with truth and love.
  - A. The compassion of Christ is our example.
  - B. The truth and the love of Jesus lift the burden of shame and condemnation. [Romans 9:33 \(NIV\)](#), [Hebrews 12:2 \(NIV\)](#)

Conclusion:

- A. If you are one who is struggling under the burden of sin, be it abortion or something else, my friend, Jesus came to save sinners. [Matthew 9:12-13](#)
- B. Church; let us offer the compassion, the truth and the love of Jesus to post abortion parents or any other sinner.
