Title: Remember to Reject False Teachers
Text: 2 Peter 2:1-22
Date: 4/13/08

Introduction:

- A. Christians, the Apostle Peter wants to give us some things to remember.**
- B. But beware for false prophets will try to lead you astray.**

Body:

- I. Remember that there will always be false teachers in the church.**
 - A. They will secretly introduce destructive heresies**
 - B. Many will follow their shameful ways.**
 - C. But the greater concern is that many false teachers show up in the church.**
- II. Remember that God is not compromised by false teachers.**
 - A. To tell a lie does not change the truth but it does have consequences.**
 - B. Remember, God did not spare angels when they sinned but sent them to hell.**
 - C. Remember that God did not spare the ancient world.**
 - D. Remember God condemned Sodom and Gomorrah burning them to ashes.**
- III. Remember that false teachers may look and sound good but are doomed to a tragic end.**
 - A. Don't be deceived for they follow the corrupt and sinful nature and despise authority.**
 - B. They were unclean to begin with and have reverted to their uncleanness.**

Conclusion:

- A. Jesus is the way, the truth, and the life. No one comes to the Father but by Him. (John 14:6)**
