Introduction:

Body:

I. How can a young man keep his way pure?

A. What about your path in life?

II. The answer to the question is, "By living according to Your Word." (9)

A. First, he says, "I will seek you with all my heart."(10)

B. Second, he disciplines himself in the study of God's Word.
